## **RESOLUTION CCR-20-17**

## A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MT. SHASTA ADOPTING A LIST OF PROJECTS TO BE FUNDED BY SB 1: THE ROAD REPAIR AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT

WHEREAS, Senate Bill 1 (SB 1), the Road Repair and Accountability Act of 2017 (Chapter 5, Statutes of 2017) was passed by the Legislature and Signed into law by the Governor in April 2017 in order to address the significant multi-modal transportation funding shortfalls statewide; and

WHEREAS, SB 1 includes accountability and transparency provisions that will ensure the residents of our City are aware of the projects proposed for funding in our community and which projects have been completed each fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City must include a list of all projects proposed to receive funding from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account (RMRA), created by SB 1, in the City budget, which must include a description and the location of each proposed project, a proposed schedule for the project's completion, and the estimated useful life of the improvement; and

WHEREAS, the City, will receive an estimated \$64,000 in RMRA funding in Fiscal Year 2020/21 from SB 1; and

WHEREAS, the City uses a Pavement Management System to develop project lists to ensure revenues are being used on the most high-priority and cost-effective projects that also meet the community's priorities for transportation investment; and

WHEREAS, the funding from SB 1 will help the City maintain and rehabilitate streets; and

NOW, THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, ORDERED AND FOUND by the City Council of the City of Mt. Shasta as follows:

The following is a list of projects planned to be funded with Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account revenues for FY 2020-21:

PROJECT NAME: Chip Seal Street Maintenance and Repairs.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Street resurfacing including, dig-outs, repair, paving overlay, crack seal and chip seal.

PROJECT LOCATION: All locations listed are an estimate and have yet to be finalized. Project location to include streets within the City Limits of the City of Mt. Shasta.

SCHEDULE: Annual street maintenance occurs from May through September of each year ESTIMATED USEFUL LIFE: 5-10 years
