



Committee Mission: The Beautification Committee was established on June 25, 1984, to improve the visual quality and general ambiance of the City of Mt. Shasta through landscaping and other actions consistent with the theme of “Beautification”. The Committee was also formed to assist in generating a sense of community pride and awareness of the quality of the local environment. The Committee acts as an Advisory Committee to the City Council by bringing forward recommendations, as needed, that would result in enhancing and improving the aesthetics of the community.

Committee Dynamics: The Committee is a five (5) member body consisting of members of the community residing inside or outside of the City limits. One (1) appropriate member of City staff assists the Committee as needed.

Meeting Frequency: On the 2nd Wednesday of each month.

Meeting Location/Time: Above the Police Department located at 303 N. Mt. Shasta Boulevard, 4 p.m.
